He completed his urologic training at the University of Michigan and currently serves as editor-in-chief, section of urology, International Urology and Nephrology journal, co-chaired the first US 1992 Guidelines for Urinary Incontinence, published over 270 journal articles and book chapters, recipient of the NIH MERIT Award and conducted multiple NIH funded research projects since 1982.
